Auchentoshan 12yr	£4.50
<i>Elegant and refined lowland malt whisky with classic Auchentoshan notes of vanilla and almonds.</i>	
Auchentoshan American Oak	£4.50
<i>Matured only in first-fill bourbon casks, this whisky is vanilla rich and fruity.</i>	
Aultmore	£5.00
<i>This clean refreshing whisky has notes of pear, apple and custard.</i>	
Balvenie 12yr	£4.50
<i>This Speyside whisky is sweet with hints of black pepper, raspberry and milk chocolate.</i>	
Balvenie 14yr	£6.00
<i>Being matured in previous Caribbean rum casks gives this malt extra sweetness and a vanilla/toffee kick.</i>	
Benraich	£6.00
<i>This single malt has fruit and flora at its heart, rounded with layered honey sweetness, orchard fruit and bourbon-cask character.</i>	
Benrinnes	£5.00
<i>The only Speyside to be triple distilled like a Lowland malt or Irish whiskey but has a lot more body and character.</i>	
Benromach	£5.00
<i>This lusciously rich Speyside single malt is a fruity, chocolatey and lightly smoky dram.</i>	
Bowmore No.1	£4.50
<i>A creamy single malt matured in first-fill bourbon casks. Sweet vanilla notes blend in with coastal peat and citrus fruits.</i>	
Bruichladdich Classic Laddie	£4.50
<i>Made entirely from Scottish-grown barley, trickle distilled and then American oak matured, this single malt has notes of cinnamon and peach.</i>	
Bunnahabhain	£6.00
<i>A typically coastal and creamy whisky with notes of caramel, nuts, dried fruits and hints of spice.</i>	

Caol Ila 12yr	£5.00
<i>This medium weight Islay is packing plenty of potent phenols and a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty.</i>	
Caol Ila Moch	£5.50
<i>Lighter in style than the 12yr this single malt is creamy and lemony with a medium-bodied palate but still packs a peaty punch!</i>	
Cardhu Amber Rock	£6.00
<i>Finished in American oak ex-bourbon casks, this malt has added notes of vanilla while retaining the Cardhu easy drinking style.</i>	
Cardhu Gold Reserve	£6.00
<i>Known for its easy drinking and sweet whisky style. This malt has been aged in toasted oak casks, giving it notes of toffee apples.</i>	
Chivas Regal 12yr	£4.20
<i>Sweet, but not cloying. Buxom, but not overblown.</i>	
Chivas Regal 15yr	
<i>Big body and sweetness in this blend gives fruity flavours due to careful cask selection including some Grande Champagne Cognac casks.</i>	
Chivas Regal 18yr	£7.50
<i>Premium aged mix of some of the finest scotch gives an above average proportion of malt and vanilla, nutmeg and cinnamon notes.</i>	
Chivas Regal Extra	
<i>This blend includes some sherry cask matured whisky, resulting in a sweet and fruity blend.</i>

<i>Released as a limited edition, this is no novice whisky. Notes of orange peel, spice, oaky malt and dark sugar.</i>	
Cu Bocan	£5.00
<i>This highland single malt has light smoky flavours intertwined with rich citrus and exotic spices.</i>	
Dalmore 12yr	£5.00
<i>Aged in both ex-bourbon and ex-sherry casks, this malt has both sweetness and rich sherry flavours.</i>	
Dalwhinnie	£4.50
<i>A good introduction to single malt whiskies - elegant, smooth and medium bodied with a light and fruity palate.</i>	

Deveron 12yr	£4.50
<i>Light and sweet with notes of citrus fruit and spice.</i>	
Dewars 15yr	£8.00
<i>A rich and nutty blended whisky matured in both bourbon and sherry casks. The palate offers walnut, fresh malt, sultanas and chewy vanilla toffee.</i>	
Glenfiddich 12yr	£4.50
<i>One of the world's best selling malts. Light and easy drinking with sweet hints of apple and cream.</i>	
Glenfiddich 15yr	£6.00
<i>This classic whisky uses three different casks married together into one to produce hints of ginger, cinnamon and marzipan.</i>	
Glenfiddich 18yr	£7.00
<i>An elegant nose, slightly sweet and scented with apple and wood. This 18yr malt is full-bodied, yet soft, rounded and long lasting.</i>	
Glenfiddich Fire and Cane	£5.00
<i>This malt is a marriage of Glenfiddich's rarely seen peated whisky and unpeated bourbon aged whisky. Resulting in a smoky, sweet whisky with caramel notes.</i>	
Glen Grant Majors Reserve	£4.50
<i>A fresh and vanilla palate with a slightly dry and hazelnut finish.</i>	
Glenlivet Captains	£4.50
<i>Finishing in casks previously containing cognac, notes of raisin and honey are created in this creamy, citrusy single malt.</i>	
Glenlivet Founders	£4.00
<i>In classic Glenlivet style, this single malt has a creamy and fruity character bolstered by the use of first-fill American oak barrels.</i>	
Glenlivet Nadurra	£5.00
<i>The distillery's most popular cask-strength, un-chillfiltered, bourbon-cask-matured, natural single malt.</i>	
Glenmorangie 10yr	£4.50
<i>This 'original' single malt is medium bodied and gently warming with slight spicy sweetness.</i>	
Glenmorangie 12yr	£4.00
<i>Finishing in Oloroso and Pedro Ximenez sherry casks, this malt has a warmth and notes of butterscotch and walnuts.</i>	

Glenrothes 10yr	£4.50
<i>Paying homage to the ageing process of sherry grapes, this malt has a slight sweetness and hints of lemon peel on the palate.</i>	
Glenturret 10yr	£4.00
<i>A lovely whisky with a distinctively fruity and deliciously rich character.</i>	
Glenturret Sherry Cask	£6.00
<i>Rich sherry aromas combine with toffee and apple on the nose, with the palate offering hints of banana, dried fruit, liquorice and toasted oak.</i>	
Glenturret Triple Wood	£4.50
<i>Aged in a combination of American and European oak sherry as well as American oak bourbon casks, this malt has distinct notes of marzipan and coconut.</i>	
Haig Club	£5.50
<i>A light and sweet grain whisky, perfect for novice whisky drinkers. Hints of lemon, cream and toffee.</i>	
Highland Park Dragon Legend	£5.00
<i>Peaty and sweet (sherry cask finished) this maly brings hints of peppercorn, mince pie and oily malts while still being clean and clear.</i>	
Highland Park Spirit of the Bear	£8.50
<i>Aromas of peat followed by coffee and dipped honey with orange peel and stem ginger on the palate.</i>	
Inchmurrin	£7.50
<i>A sweeter style of whisky from Loch Lomond, this malt gives off floral and grassy notes.</i>	
Jura French Oak	£4.50
<i>A perfect balance of sweetness, delicate smoke and light spice with notes of lime marmalade, caramel latte and vanilla on the palate.</i>	
Jura Journey	£4.50
<i>A great entry point to Jura. Softly smoky with citrus and orchard fruit notes along with dark chocolate, toffee and butter on the palate.</i>	
Jura Seven Wood	£4.50
<i>Matured through seven different casks (Bourbon, Vosges, Jupilles, Les Bertranges, Allier, Troncais and Limousin), this single malt has a spicy character intercepted by chocolate and fruits.</i>	
Kavalan	£7.00
<i>Hailing from Taiwan, this single malt is full flavoured and bursting with notes of tropical fruits such as mango and coconut.</i>	

Kilchoman Machir Bay	£5.50
<i>Matured in first-fill bourbon casks for six years before being finished in oloroso sherry butts before bottling.</i>	
Kilchoman Sanaig	£7.00
<i>An excellent balance of peat smoke and sweet citrus flavours from a combination of sherry and bourbon casks.</i>	
Kings Barn	£5.00
<i>This lowland malt really gives off aromas of first fill bourbon casks with sweet cereal and roasted coffee notes on the palate.</i>	
Lagavulin	£6.50
<i>Not for the faint hearted, this malt is deep, dry and exceptionally peaty. Also has slight notes of creosote and kelp.</i>	
Laphroaig 10yr	£4.50
<i>A full bodied smoky gem with a residual sweetness and a hint of salt amongst the seaweedy, peaty characters.</i>	
Mackmyra	£6.50
<i>A light well balanced whisky with a touch of smokiness and spicy juniper.</i>	
Monkey Shoulder	£4.50
<i>A mix of three speyside malts with touches of zesty orange, honey and honey. This whisky is sweet, smooth and easy to drink.</i>	
Mortlach 12yr	£5.00
<i>Combining ex-bourbon and ex-sherry casks, this entry whisky balances dried fruit and weighty characters against vanilla and fresh sweet fruit flavours.</i>	
Oban	£6.00
<i>A superb westland highland single malt with a full-bodied fruity flavour and a whiff of heather and more than a hint of smokiness.</i>	
Poit Dhubh	£4.50
<i>A dark smokiness runs through this 12 yo single malt along with just a hint of sweet citrus.</i>	
Port Charlotte 10	£7.00
<i>A heavy hitting peaty whisky with a maritime twang. Flavours of smoke and cream also lift up towards the palate.</i>	
Royal Lochnagar	£5.00
<i>A favourite of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, this single malt has a medium body and hint of sweetness with lemon, lychee and toffee flavours.</i>	

Scapa	£4.50
<i>A lightly smoky single malt aged in American oak and ex-peated-whisky casks. The result is fruity and creamy with touches of peach, vanilla and caramel.</i>	
Singleton 15yr	£4.50
<i>A mix of American and European oak casks produce a whisky that is smooth and sweet, with a spicy drying finish.</i>	
Singleton Malt Masters Special	£4.50
<i>Made by the distilleries Master of Malts, this single malt has hints of rich toffee, vanilla and a suggestion of pear drops.</i>	
Singleton Spey Cascade	£4.50
<i>Aged in a mix of bourbon and sherry casks, this warming whisky has touches of baked orchard fruits, demerara sugar and golden barley.</i>	
Singleton Sunray	£4.50
<i>A smooth, sweet, honeyed whisky aged exclusively in American Oak casks.</i>	
Speyburn Bradan Orach	£4.50
<i>A no-age expression from Speyburn finished in bourbon barrels.</i>	
Spice King	£4.00
<i>A sweet, spicy and earthy 8 year old blended whisky.</i>	
Stronachie	£5.00
<i>A perfectly balanced and seductive dram with notes of luscious honey and biscuits along with hints of pepper and cereal.</i>	
Talisker Skye	£5.50
<i>Taking the distillery's rugged character and softening out, this easy drinking Talisker maintains the smoky and sweet notes the distillery is known for.</i>	
Tamnavulin	£4.20
<i>Finished in sherry butts, this double cask malt has notes of dried orange, ginger and wood spice.</i>	
Tomatin 14yr	£6.00
<i>Extra notes of dried fruitiness is added to the classic highland notes of honey and toffee from the finish being in tawny-port pipes.</i>	
Tomatin Legacy	£4.50
<i>Aged in a combination of bourbon barrels and virgin-oak casks, this whisky is brimming with notes of pineapple, marshmallow, lemon and vanilla.</i>	

Japanese: (note, all Japanese whiskies are £7.50 per 35ml measure)

Akashi

This version of Akashi uses a mixture of Japanese and Foreign made malt and whisky grains to produce an everyday blend.

Mars Maltage 'Cosmo'

A blended malt whisky with notes of vanilla and walnuts alongside fresh orange, chocolate and oaky spices.

Nikka Coffey Grain

Produced mainly from corn using one of their continuous coffey stills, this malt has oodles of exotic flavours such as mango, papaya and coconut.

Nikka Pure Malt

A true example of what Japanese whisky is truly capable of. Flavours of vanilla, smoke, dark chocolate and coffee.

Togouchi 12yr

This 12 year old blended whisky is a mix of Scotch malt and Canadian grain creating a fruity and citrus rich whisky.

Yamazaki

One of the first Japanese whiskies to break into the UK market, this 12yo malt continues to impress novice and experienced drinkers with its well-balanced fruity sweetness.
